Dear Parishioners and Friends,


June has many special Sunday celebrations this year. On the 1<sup>st</sup> we celebrate Ascension Sunday and the next Sunday, the 8<sup>th</sup>, is Pentecost Sunday. June 15<sup>th</sup> is Trinity Sunday, Father's Day, and a day to celebrate the ministry of Deacons in our Diocese. Cathy Harper will be our guest preacher, and Bob Sherwood will participate in the liturgy.

On June 22 we mark the weekend when summer officially begins; the longest day of the year with sunlight is normally June 20 - 22. This Sunday also marks the start of the long, green (liturgical color) season after Pentecost.

June 29<sup>th</sup> is a celebration of St. Peter and St. Paul. We will have one service at 9 AM followed by a festive coffee hour. This is a wonderful opportunity for those who worship at 8am every Sunday to join with those who attend at 10am.

We look forward to summer for many months. Enjoy the start and the entire summer season "day by day".

The 1979 Book of Common Prayer and the calendar of the Episcopal Church have 2 special Feast days for St. Peter.

On January 18<sup>th</sup> we celebrate Peter's confession - proclaiming Jesus as the Messiah, the Christ. On June 29<sup>th</sup>, we remember Peter's Apostolic ministry and his martyrdom. Both of these days give us a chance to give thanks for our parish's "Feast of Title", being named for Peter.

On the June 29 celebration St. Paul is joined with St. Peter, presumably because of their shared ministry in Rome, and because in some traditions, it is thought that they were martyred together.

The 16th century English Reformers didn't want to include 2 feast for one Saint, so they dropped Peter's January Feast and Paul's June Feast. The 1979 BCP is the first to include both for Peter and both for Paul.

Since June 29<sup>th</sup> is also the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month, we will have one special Eucharist at 9am, followed by a festive coffee hour. We hope everyone will join us to celebrate St. Peter and the start of the 4th of July week.
